SIERRA BLANCA



LA CONCHA

Rising to 1,215 m, La Concha is one of the most recognisable peaks on the Costa del Sol and a natural viewpoint over Marbella and the Mediterranean.

GEOLOGY

Sierra Blanca takes its name from the pale limestone rock shaped over millions of years by erosion.

MICROCLIMATE
