The real risks of going solo.



No coverage for accidents.

A sprain or a fall without insurance can quickly turn into a rescue situation and a bill you'll have to cover.



Unsuitable shoes or gear

Wearing street shoes on wet rocks or tricky terrain is the leading reason for falls.



Without a local guide who's familiar with the area

Emergency exits, shifts in weather, and backup routes: a certified local guide is already aware of all this.



Not enough water and supplies

The heat and effort in Sierra Blanca can be easily overlooked, even on shorter trails.



Kids on exposed terrain

Canyons, via ferratas and exposed terrain are not a game — take extreme caution.



No active SOS app.

Without SOSfy (or a similar app) set up and activated before you head out, no one will know where to find you — and signal coverage in the mountains is patchy or non-existent.

IF YOU CONTINUE TO GO ON YOUR OWN

Essential checklist before heading out



Turn on SOSfy (or another location/SOS app) and share it with someone you trust.



Tell someone your exact route and when you expect to be back.



Bring more water than you think you'll need. (Check the area in advance for water sources)



Wear the right shoes and gear suited for the terrain.



Check the weather forecast before you head out, not when you get there.



Steer clear of tricky or exposed areas if you're heading out with kids.
